VENDOR AGREEMENT

On June 4, 2004 SSG Frank Carvill and SPC Christopher Duffy were killed in a mortar attack in Baghdad. The following day SSG Humberto Timoteo and SGT Ryan Doltz died after their vehicle hit an IED. All four men were members of 3/112th FA of the New Jersey Army National Guard. Both SSG Timoteo and SPC Duffy left behind young sons.

Our families have decided to honor the memory of "Our Fallen Heroes" with the Band of Brothers Memorial Poker Run to be held on Sunday, June 6, 2010 (rain date – June 13, 2010). The run will begin and end at the Fireman's Field in Mine Hill, NJ. It will be a family style event with food, music, prizes, and fun for everyone. All of the profits will be divided between the Friends of Frank Carvill Foundation, the SGT Ryan E. Doltz Memorial Foundation, Inc. and the Duffy and Timoteo families.

We are in the process of planning the event and are currently seeking vendors that can offer a wide range of services to our patrons. Registration for run participants will begin at 8am followed by the picnic beginning at 12pm and finally our awards ceremony at 3:30pm.

TERMS

- I. Space Designation and Equipment
 - a. Each vendor space will consist of a **20' x 10' area**. Vendors will be responsible for providing all items and materials required to make their designated space suitable for their purposes. The Band of Brothers Memorial Poker Run Committee (the "Committee") will not supply electricity, water, gas, or any other utilities, tables, chairs, coverings, etc. It is the responsibility of the vendor to bring all necessary equipment. All equipment must be contained within the designated area and cannot interfere with patron right of way or other vendor spaces. Vendors acknowledge that only one side of their designated vendor space may be available for selling of merchandise.
 - b. Vendors should occupy their spaces from **7:30am until 4:30pm**. Vendors arriving after 7:30am will be required to hand-carry or hand-cart their merchandise and support materials to the space or spaces assigned by the Committee. The Committee cannot provide support of equipment such as hand-carts, etc. to assist vendors in occupying their assigned vendor space or spaces. All vacant vendor spaces as of 7:30am will be subject to reassignment by the Committee.

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- c. If a vendor brings a generator, only the use of quiet generators will be allowed. All electrical connections must not interfere with patron right of ways or other vendors. All electrical connections and gas powered machinery are subject to inspection by the Mine Hill Fire Inspector.
- II. Registration Fees
 - a. Each vendor space will be available for a **\$50 non-refundable fee**.
 - b. To reserve a vendor space the vendor must complete and return the attached Vendor Application along with payment by **May 19, 2010**. Vendor spaces will not be allocated or considered 'reserved' until payment has been received in full. Vendors will be notified by e-mail once their reservation is determined to be complete.
 - c. All fees are considered a donation. If the event is rescheduled to the rain date, the vendor will be notified by e-mail. The Committee will not be held liable for e-mails not received because of Internet Provider issues or vendor e-mail issues. Furthermore, the Committee will not be held liable for the cancellation/shortening of the event due to police actions taken by Mine Hill Township or actions taken by the Wharton/Mine Hill Police Department.
 - d. Checks returned due to insufficient funds will be charged a \$50 fee.
 - III. Insurance
 - a. Vendors that bring machinery, equipment, or vehicles that will come in contact with or partly/wholly be operated by customers/event attendants must supply the Committee a certificate of insurance issued by a reputable insurer evidencing coverage for:
 - i. Comprehensive general liability with a combined single limit of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury, including personal injury, and property damage.
 - b. The insurance certificate must name The Family of SSG Frank Carvill, The Family of SPC Christopher Duffy, The Family of SSG Humberto Timoteo, The Family of SGT Ryan Doltz, the Friends of Frank Carvill Foundation, Inc., the SGT Ryan E. Doltz Memorial Foundation, Inc., the Mine Hill Fire Department, and Mine Hill Township as additional insureds.
 - c. Insurance certificates must be supplied by **May 24, 2010** to:

 - IV. Indemnification
 - a. Vendors, including owners and members and associates of the organization, agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Committee, its members and its agents from and against all claims, liabilities, suits, losses, damages, and expenses, including costs and attorney's fees

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relating to or resulting from any events or circumstances occurring during the Band of Brothers Memorial Poker Run.

V. Miscellaneous

- a. The Committee, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to reject any Vendor Application, including but not limited to, deeming certain merchandise as unacceptable for sale at this event. Any Vendor Application rejected in full will be eligible for a refund of pre-paid Registration Fees.
